Have you logged in to Destiny? Our online catalog also allows you to place reserves on needed materials. Use the instructions below to learn how to log in to your personal account.

From the Destiny home page, choose our school. From the school's Destiny page, click "Log In" in the top right-hand corner. Your user name will be the same one that the school has assigned to you in Windows. Your password will be your birthday in the

following format: YY/MM/DD Note that this is different from the way you type it to log into Windows. The year has been moved to the front of the password. To place a reserve, look up the book you want to reserve. Click on the title. On the right side of the screen across from the title click "Hold it".
