Between the Bridges Winter Festival

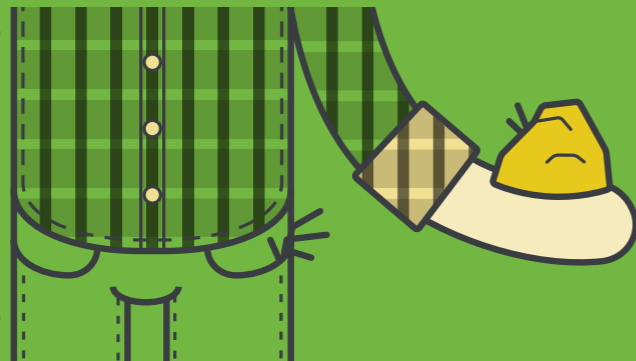
